- Contact the Ombudsman or his Deputy if you have a problem with an official authority, if you are treated differently from other children (for example because of your skin colour, religion, health, sex, or country of origin) or if you have problems for example in the children's home.
- One of us will contact you as soon as possible, in three days the latest.

THE OMBUDSMAN CAN HELP YOU WHEN, FOR EXAMPLE:

- someone is treating somebody else badly just because of his age, skin colour, health, nationality, religion, or sex
- your family does not have enough money for your school supplies, free-time activities, school trip, skiing course or summer camp
- you have a problem with the contact with your divorced parents
- you were not accepted to school
- there is a risk that your parents might be expelled from the country
- you have troubles at school because you do not speak Czech well yet
- the social worker is not acting correctly
- the judicial proceedings is taking too long
- nobody solved your complaint on a non functioning item
- somebody is putting waste somewhere he is not supposed to and the official authority is not solving it



THE OMBUDSMAN CANNOT:

- change the decision of a court
- enter into the investigation of the Police
- intervene when people have disputes among themselves
